Elementary Student Supply List

As you know, or will quickly learn, our classroom extends well beyond the walls of our building. Journey's School Elementary students should come to school each day prepared for indoor and outdoor activities. If you have any questions or concerns about this list, do not hesitate to call your student's advisor.

PLEASE BE SURE TO LABEL ALL BELONGINGS!

Items to be kept in your child's mudroom cubby at school :

- ___ Backpack for day-to-day use to and from school and on journeys
- ___ Indoor shoes to wear in the classroom (*These shoes must have sturdy soles in case of a fire drill or emergency*)
- ___ Hiking or Outdoor Shoes (*Sturdy all-weather shoes appropriate for hiking*)
- ___ Snow Gear: pants, jacket, winter boots, gloves, warm hat, and warm layers (to be used in winter weather)
- ___ Rain Gear: water-proof pants and jacket (*to be used in fall and spring weather*)
- ___ Sunglasses with UVA/UVB protection
- ___ Sun Hat with a brim (*baseball type or full brim*)
- ___ Lip balm with UVA/UVB protection
- ___ Sunscreen with 30+ SPF
- ___ One-liter water bottle with screw top lid (with child's name labeled on all parts)
- ___ One or two dry or canned microwavable meal(s) for days your child forgets his/her lunch.

Kindergarten, First & Second Grade Supplies:

- ___ Oops Kit: Extra change of clothes for those "oops" days preferably in a Ziploc bag. Please include pants, shirt, underwear, and socks. Please clearly label the bag with your child's name.

Third, Fourth, & Fifth Grade Supplies:

- ___ Three sets of 5 dividers for use in 3-ring binders
- ___ One 2" white 3-ring binder with clear plastic covers. (We know this is specific, but your child will build his/her portfolio in this binder. We would like all portfolio binders to be the same).
- ___ One 1 1/2" dark green binder (Again, we know this is specific, but these binders will be used in math class)
- ___ One flash drive (1 gigabyte will be sufficient.) It can be purchased at an office supply store for around \$15.00. This device will help your child transfer electronic files between home and school computers.

Optional CLASSROOM SUPPLIES:

If you would like to donate classroom supplies, we would greatly appreciate: #2 pencils, pencil top erasers, Kleenex, sunscreen, hand sanitizer, ELMERS glue sticks, colored pencils, thick and thin CRAYOLA markers, dry erase markers and erasers, dividers, sticky notes, sponges, quart and gallon size plastic baggies, thick and thin permanent sharpies, eco-friendly dishwasher detergent, eco-friendly dish soap, and washcloths for cleaning.

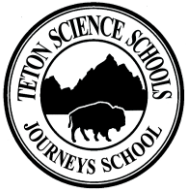

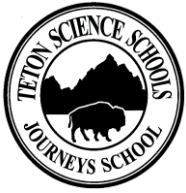

After School Explorations Program (Grades PreK-2)

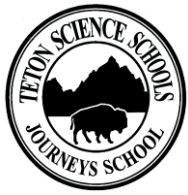
The goal for the After School Explorations Program is to provide a safe and cooperative extended day program in which children can learn, explore, play, collaborate, and be creative. We are looking forward to another happy and successful afterschool program!

- **Description:** The After School Explorations Program is available to all students enrolled at Journey's School in grades PreK-2. The program is five days a week, Monday through Friday, from 3:30-5:30 pm. Each afternoon, the children receive snack, have free choice time for play and exploration, and participate in engaging and creative activities. This program is student centered, directed by their interests and energy, and is subject to change accordingly.
- **Schedule:** The After School Explorations Program follows the school calendar, beginning on the first day of school, August 31st, and continuing through the last day of the school year, June 12th. You may enroll for one day per week, all week, or even once a month.
- **Faculty:** Bree Buckley was a Teton Science Schools' summer instructor. We welcome her to the pre-kindergarten classroom and the After School Explorations Program.
- **Cost:** The cost for students who are pre-registered for the After School Explorations Program is \$15/day. The cost for drop-in is \$20/day and notification a day in advance is requested to assure we can include your child in our limited space program. Billing will be sent at the end of each trimester.

After School Enrichment Program (Grades 3-12)

Course details will be provided at the end of August

- **Description:** The After School Enrichment Program is available to all students enrolled at Journey's School in grades 3-12. If space allows, non-Journey's School students will be allowed to enroll in classes. Specific class information will be available three weeks before each session begins. Some classes will meet once per week, some may meet twice per week.
- **Schedule:**
 - Fall classes will meet for nine weeks, September 19th through the week of November 14th.
 - Winter classes will meet for nine weeks, January 16th through the week of March 19th, with no classes the week of February 20th.
 - Spring classes will meet for six weeks, the week of April 16th through the week of May 21st.
- **Location and Time:** Classes meet in Journey's School classrooms and will be defined with each offering. Classes will meet from 3:30-5:00pm.
- **Faculty:** Varies based on the class – Specific class information will be available three weeks before each session begins.
- **Cost:** Each nine week session will be \$135 for classes that meet once per week / \$270 if two days per week. Six week sessions will be \$90 for classes that meet once per week / \$180 if two days per week. At this time, tuition assistance aid is not available for the enrichment programs. Extra experiences, such as the Robotics tournament, will have extra costs.
- **Registration:** Students will need to sign up for an entire session; drop-in is not available for the After School Enrichment Program. All classes require a minimum of six students and are limited to a maximum of twelve students.
